“Beauty is not in the face but is a light in the heart.”

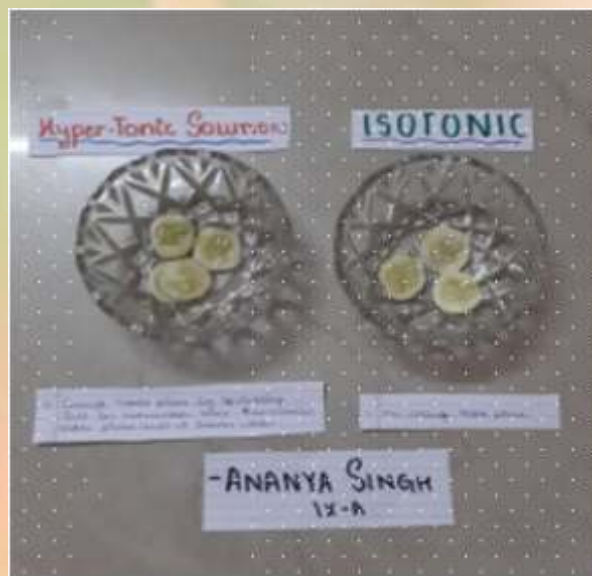

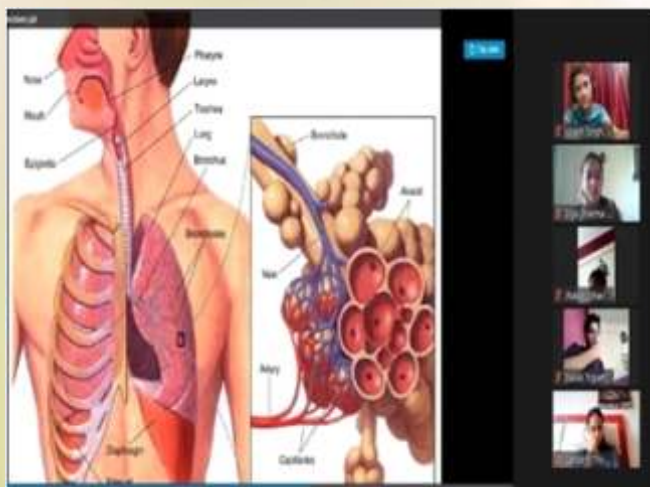

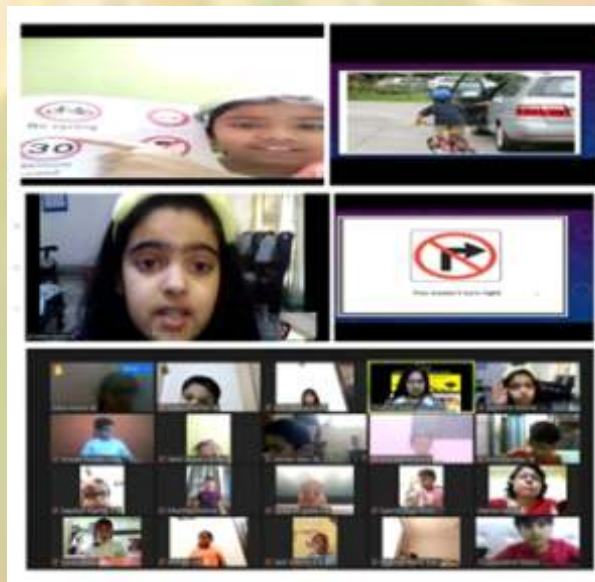

One should be thoughtful while writing about any issue. Apt language should be used and contractions and short forms should be avoided. One must have a balanced approach and derogatory language should be avoided absolutely. Polite and discreet language should be the base of all writing skills. He suggested to plan before writing and explained that students to think about the topics beforehand and then divide them into different paragraphs. Conclusion should be to the point, and repetition and scribbling should be avoided by all means.

Key Message: -

Peers are people who are part of the same social group, so the term "peer pressure" means the influence that peers can have on each other.

Resource person discussed six types of Peer Pressure:

Spoken Peer Pressure: Spoken peer pressure is when a teenager asks, suggests, persuades or otherwise directs another to engage in a specific behaviour.

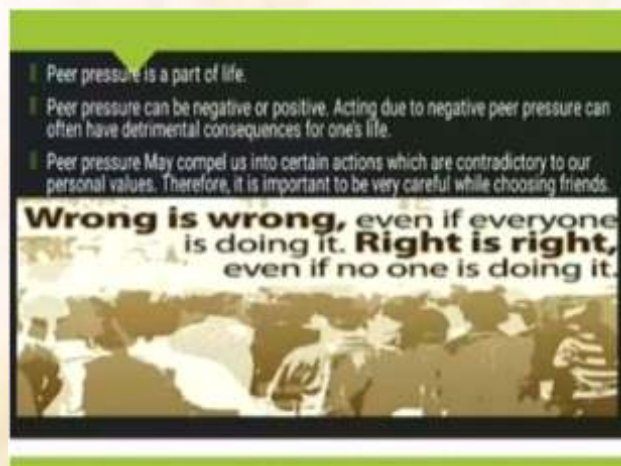
Unspoken Peer Pressure: With unspoken peer pressure, a teenager is exposed to the actions of one or more peers and is left to choose whether they want to follow along.

Direct Peer Pressure: Direct peer pressure is normally behavior centric.

Indirect Peer Pressure: When a teen overhears a friend gossiping about another person and then reacts to the gossip, that is indirect peer pressure.

Negative Peer Pressure: Asking a young teenager to engage in behaviour that is against their moral code or family values is a type of negative peer pressure.

Positive Peer Pressure: A group dynamic can be a positive peer influence if the behaviour is healthy, age appropriate and socially acceptable. Resource person also shared the tips for young people to say “No” in different situations. The session was attended by Ms. Anjana Masih and Ms. Shubhra Yadav.

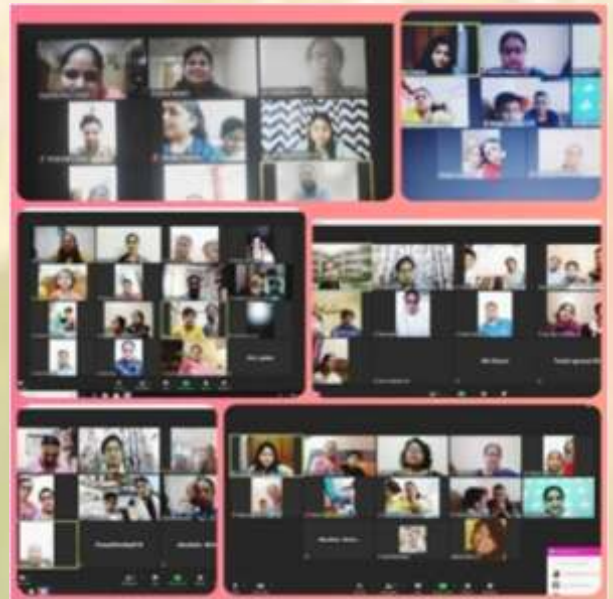

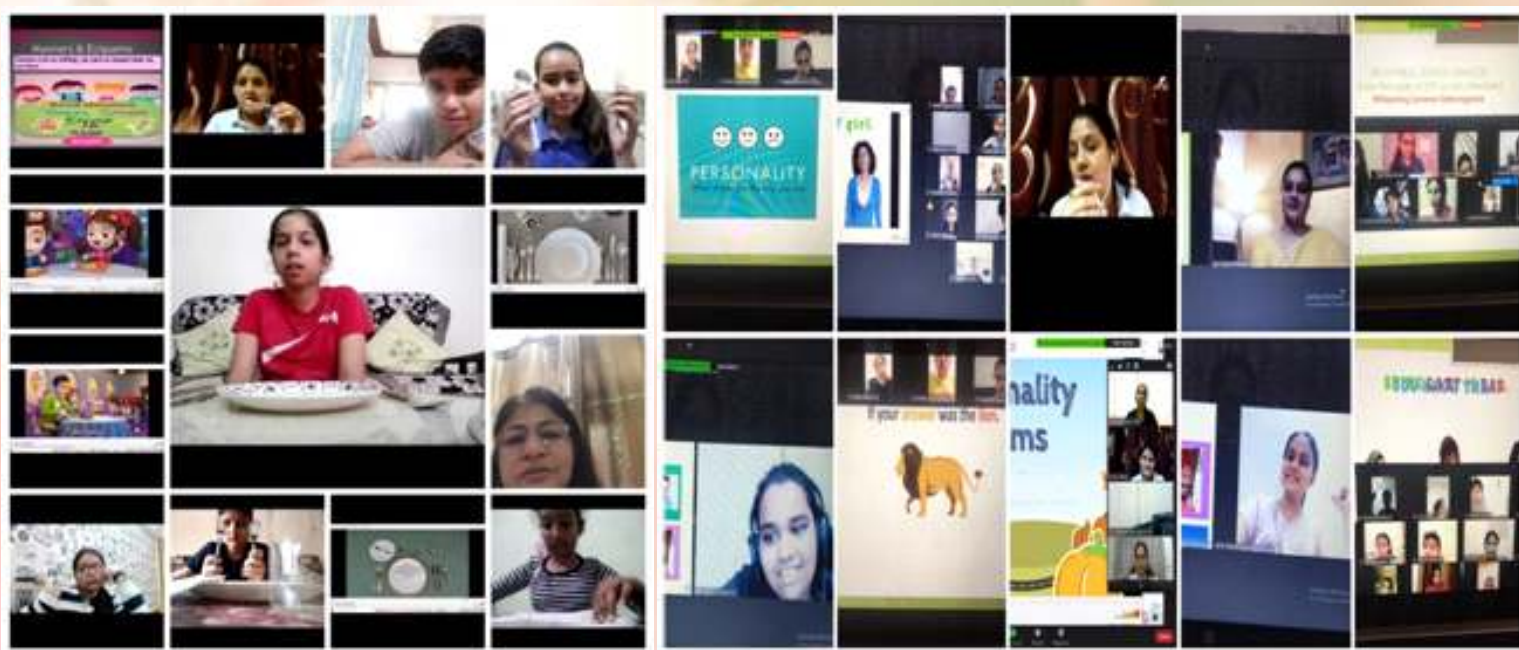
