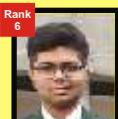

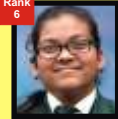

Fit India Campaign (Class IX)



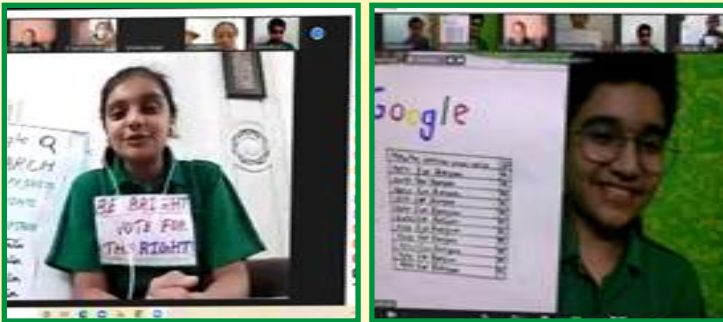

वर्चुअल हास्य कविता प्रतियोगिता

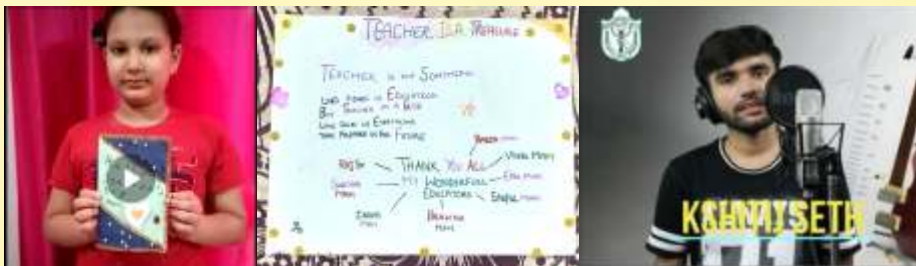

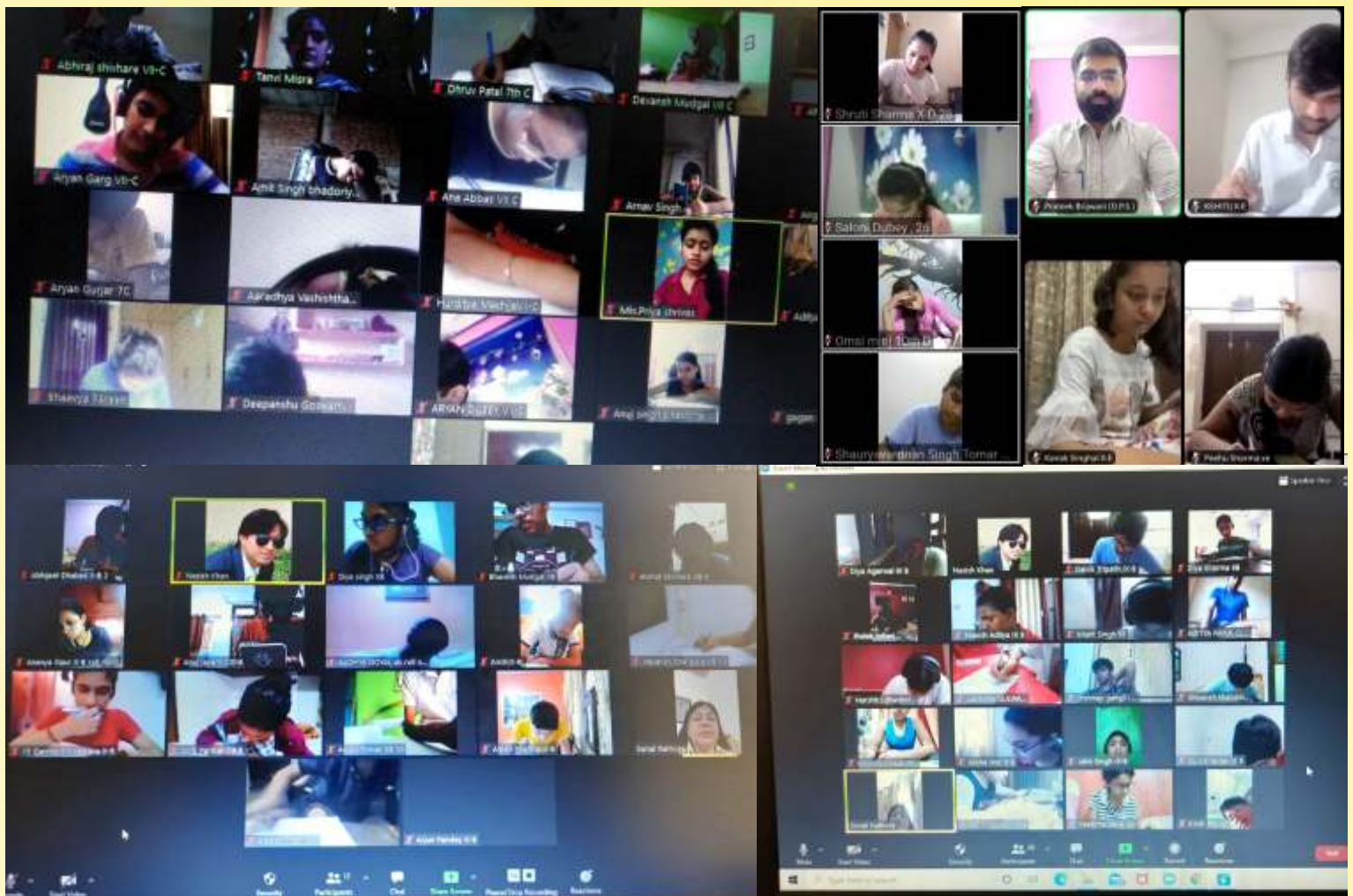
